Public Meeting in Placerville for Echo Summit Bridge Project

Caltrans Seeking Comments on Draft Environmental Document

PLACERVILLE – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is hosting a public meeting on Wednesday, October 26 regarding its plans for a bridge replacement project on U.S. Highway 50 over Echo Summit.

The event is scheduled from **5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. with a project presentation at 6 p.m.** at the Placerville Town Hall City Council Chambers, 549 Main Street, Placerville. Community members will have the opportunity to view displays and ask questions from Caltrans staff members.

The project's [draft environmental document](#) is currently circulating and comment cards will be available. Comments are being accepted until Friday, November 18.

The bridge replacement project is scheduled to go into construction in 2019 and take two seasons to complete. Project alternatives include full closures of Highway 50 from 10 to 30 days, depending on the alternative selected.

Caltrans District 3 is responsible for maintaining and operating 4,385 lane miles in 11 Sacramento Valley and Northern Sierra counties.
