

• **KINNELON ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION MINUTES**
July 30, 2015

MEETING TO ORDER:

Chairperson Cheryl Canale stated this meeting is being held pursuant to the New Jersey Open Public Meeting Act. Adequate notice of this meeting was given by advertising in the January 11, 2015 edition of the Trends and was provided to the Star Ledger, Daily Record and the North Jersey Herald News. Adequate notice was also posted on the municipal building bulletin board, filed with the Environmental Secretary and provided to those persons or entities requesting notification.

- Councilwoman Sventy will ask the council what is happening with the clothing bins located at the recycle center.
