Dale Olson and Randy Nohova will proceed with putting together a bid for a pickup which shall not cost more than the budgeted amount of \$29,000.00. It is anticipated that the pick-up truck would be delivered in April,/May 2012. The police would like to take possession of the Tahoe as soon as the Board will permit.

Rick Bush discussed with the MUB the Vanocker Canyon Corridor Utility Extension Project update and the SD DOT-Lazelle Street Mill & Overlay Project/water Main reconstruction.

A motion was made to go into Executive Session SDCL 1-25-2 at 8:45 A.M. to consider a personnel question and to discuss a contract matter, that being the revisions to the draft Operating Agreement.
