Approved.

Gary Patterson was present to get direction from the Water Board regarding the water leak at 1222 Fulton for Sam Patterson. Eric Tibbetts, gave an overview of the situation. Randy Nohava, suggested setting up a meeting right after the Board Meeting with Eric Tibbetts Water Utilities Superintendent, Dale Olson, Operation Supervisor, and himself Randy Nohava to discuss and give Gary Patterson some options to solve the problem.

A motion by Ken Sabers and seconded by Dan Mayer to waive the tap fee and the price of the Curb Stop for Sam Patterson. Approved.

Discussed the Marshall Street Project. The project was started the week of May 11, 2011. Completion is estimated to be around the middle of June.

Rick bush, Community Development Director discussed the drainage in the Industrial Park. A Pre-Construction meeting is to be held on May 11, 2011.

A motion was made by Dan Mayer and Seconded by Ken Sabers to go into Executive Session to discuss a Personnel matter. Approved. A motion was made by Ken Sabers and seconded by Dan Mayer to come out of Executive Session. Approved.

A motion by Dan Mayer and seconded by Ken Sabers to adjourn the Municipal Board Meeting.
