Mr. Coogan doesn't want the negative actions at the airport to go too far but wants to focus on the positive stuff. Motion by Benish, 2nd by Demby, to recommend Mark Meives to the County Board for approval to 6 serve on the Iowa County Airport Commission. Motion carried. No rezone requests. Motion by Walmer, 2nd by Christen, to approve the new hangar lease for Archer Aviation, Hangar 8 (14). Motion carried. Cory Johnson was not present to discuss this topic.
