6	UW-Extension Department Head Paul Ohlrogge held a discussion on the County Farm land which is currently in the CRP program. Paul has also been talking to the DNR because they have an interest in the land. At a future meeting Paul will bring another report on the CRP land and information on the land lease with the Prairie Restoration Group.	
7 & 8	<p>John Cain, who was the architect of the 2005 jail plan, was on hand to discuss a design of the new jail and the possibility of having a regional jail that was also discussed some years ago. John said it would take about 10 months to design new and about 16 months after the design is approved to build the jail. Sheriff Michek and Jail Administrator Pam Steffes also participated in the discussion.</p> <p>Sup. Peterson moved to study the jail concept, how many inmates have mental health issues and how would the new building be funded. Sup. Parman seconded the motion. Carried.</p>
