

**Minutes**  
**Iowa County Long Range Planning Committee**  
**December, 13, 2010**

The Long Range Planning Committee met in the County Board Room of the Iowa County Courthouse in the City of Dodgeville on December 13, 2010 at 6:00 P.M. The meeting was called to order by Committee Chair Carol Anderson

Committee Members present were Carol Anderson, Dan Curran, James Griffiths, and Dan Oleson, Dave Bauer arrived 6:10. Excused Jeremy Meek, and Greg Parman. Also present Curt Kephart Administrator and Paul Ohlrogge UW-EX

Administrator Kephart read the certification of the meeting.

. Motion to approve the November 15, 2010 minutes by Griffiths, second Oleson, approved.

Paul Ohlrogge reviewed the draft "Survey Monkey" questionnaire and plan for distribution to county board members and staff. There was a general discussion of the Long-Range Planning and priorities. This included the additional functionality and flexibility the new Health and Human Services brings to the county.

The committee asked Chair Anderson to determine which meeting room in the new Health and Human Services building would best accommodate the needs of the Long Range Planning Committee and reserve it for the January meeting of the committee.
