- 1. Call to order. Bill Ehr called the meeting to order at 6pm.
- 2. Roll Call. Godfrey read the roll.

3. Certification of notice for this meeting. Godfrey noted this meeting was duly posted and noticed as required by law.

Motion to accept by McGuire Second by Bunker Motion carries.

4. Review and approval of the Mar 19, 2008 minutes

5. Approval of agenda

Motion to approve McGuire Second by Hiltbrand Motion carries 6. Petition by John & Lesley Houck for consideration of a conditional use permit to allow the division of an existing AR-1 lot into lots of 2.0 & 3.3 acres in part of the S1/2-SW of S28-T6N-R3E in the Town of Dodgeville.

Motion to approve by Hiltbrand Second by McGuire Motion carries unanimously

7. Petition by Jim & Marge Dedecker and John, Vern & Evy Halverson for a land use change to create two lots of 6.598 & 6.613 acres from A-1 Ag to AR-1 Ag Res being in part of the SW/NW of S19-T7N-R4E in the Town of Dodgeville.

Applicant present: John & Vern Halverson Town present: Curt Peterson

Godfrey present staff report. Handed out packet of 12 emails in opposition

Curt Peterson stated how the town recommendation to approve is based on consistency with the town comprehensive plan

Public comment:

Betsy D'Angelo presented a petition with 45 signatures of opposition and stated her own opposition

Charles Wegener stated his opposition referring to driveway spacing to County Road Z

Lewis Llama, representing Elizabeth Wegener, stated his and her opposition Joan Cabbot stated her opposition for the likely increase in traffic and residential density

John Manning stated his opposition feeling the intention of the proposed AR-1 district doesn't fit the proposal

Bevery D'Angelo read a statement of opposition referring to traffic safety concerns, the precedent that could be set for further area development, the loss of cropland and potential negative impacts on nearby rock formations

Bob Bunker stated his opposition out of concern that sporadic development would destroy the magnificence of the area

Shannon O'Donnel objected for the impact on the beauty of the land John Manning stated opposition for the impact on the fieldland

Mike Dearing questioned the current zoning status of the lot. Discussion resulted in Godfrey stating his report of it being "grandfathered" may not be correct and can confirm with further research.

Ehr asked Peterson for the basis on which the town determined consistency with the town comprehensive plan. Peterson replied that it is eligible for a "one-time split" so the residential density doesn't apply.

Motion by McGuire to deny in regard rural area and interest in neighbors Second by Bunker Vote: aye – McGuire & Bunker nay – Thomas & Hiltbrand Chair votes in opposition so motion fails

Thomas moves to postpone April hearing date so Godfrey can confirm present zoning status Second Dwayne Hiltbrand

Vote: aye – Hiltbrand & Thomas nay – McGuire & Bunker Ehr votes to the affirmative so motion carries

Chair calls for recess. 7:18 Chair call meeting back to order at 7:25
