Regional Planning Commission to Meet

PLATTEVILLE April 20, 2015 - - The Southwestern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (SWWRPC) will meet at 9:30 a.m., on Tuesday, April 28, for their annual strategic planning exercise at the Folklore Village on Hwy BB, in Iowa County. The morning session will begin by focusing on the achievements and challenges of the SWWRPC over the past year and will be led by staff. Following, a discussion with the Commissioners of future challenges and opportunities will take place. The Commission's regular business meeting will follow in the afternoon, where minutes and a financial report will be reviewed and a resolution accepting a planning grant from the US Dept. of Commerce, Economic Development Administration, will be considered for adoption. The SWWRPC Draft 2016 Budget will be presented and a discussion of succession planning and staffing will occur. Updates on current contracts upcoming meetings will also take place.

All meetings of the Commission are open to the public.

SWWRPC provides intergovernmental planning and coordination of community development planning, economic development, and transportation. In response to local and regional goals, the Commission and its Staff work to enhance fiscal and physical resources and to balance local and regional development, preservation, conservation, and social priorities.
