

A RESOLUTION
REAFFIRMING THE IOWA COUNTY FAIR HOUSING ORDINANCE
AND ADDING
THE PROTECTED CLASSES OF HANDICAPPED AND PERSONS WITH CHILDREN

WHEREAS, the United States Government through the Federal Code and the State of Wisconsin, by Statute, have in force Fair Housing Ordinances that govern the activities of all citizens relative to Fair Housing Opportunities; and

WHEREAS, Iowa County and certain of its Municipalities enacted Fair Housing Ordinances during the fall of 1980; and


WHEREAS, the Ordinances provided for local resolution of questions concerning freedom of housing choice by all individuals and groups identified in said Ordinances.


WHEREAS, two groups of persons, handicapped individuals and households with children, have been added to protective classes under state and federal housing laws.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors hereby reaffirms the Iowa County Fair Housing Ordinance; and that handicapped persons and households with children be added to protected groups, and that public notice be made in the newspapers of the County.


