

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A SMALL BUSINESS LOAN
FROM THE IOWA COUNTY REVOLVING LOAN FUND
(Application No. 12-2/92)

WHEREAS, **George Breiwa II, President of Chimney Specialists, Inc.**, is proposing to purchase the building he is currently leasing from Donald McGuire in the Village of Highland; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Committee on Finance, Bonds and Insurance, acting as the Iowa County Loan Review Committee, has received an application for partial financing of the project; and


WHEREAS, the amount requested from the Iowa County Revolving Loan Fund is \$15,000, approximately 30.6 percent of the total cost of the project, with other participatory financing through the SBA and the Village of Highland; and


WHEREAS, the Committee finds that the project is consistent with the conditions set forth in the Iowa County Loan Administration Manual; and


WHEREAS, the benefits to be derived and the terms agreed upon as set forth in the attached Project Summary are satisfactory.

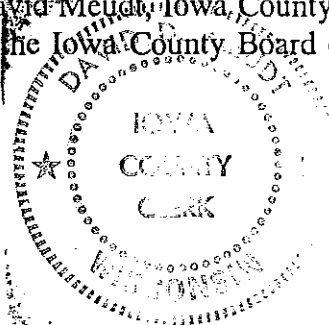


