RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A SMALL BUSINESS LOAN FROM THE IOWA COUNTY REVOLVING LOAN FUND (Application No. 30-5/02)

- WHEREAS, Laura Kindseth d/b/a The Gourmet Granny, LLC, is proposing to open a new bakery and café, to be located at 148 High in Mineral Point, and
- WHEREAS, the Iowa County Committee on Finance, Bonds, Insurance, and Tax Claims, acting as the Iowa County Loan Review Committee, has received a request from the small business concern for \$15,000 from the Iowa County RLF, to be matched with \$88,000 in a personal loan (already approved) from Farmers Savings Bank of Mineral Point, \$40,000 down payment from the owner, and \$15,000 from the City of Mineral Point revolving loan fund, for a total project cost of \$158,000 of which the Iowa County RLF funds will be used only for non-construction related items, specifically, the purchase of machinery, equipment, and furnishings (approximately \$12,000) and inventory and other working capital (approximately \$3,000), and
- WHEREAS, the Committee finds that the project is consistent with the conditions set forth in the Iowa County Loan Administration Manual; and
- WHEREAS, the benefits to be derived and the terms agreed upon as set forth in the attached Project Summary are satisfactory.
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Loan Review Committee recommends that the proposed project be approved by the full County Board.
