

POLICY ON SECURE DETENTION COSTS

Effective Date: February 1, 2003


The Iowa County Committee on Courts, Justice and Law Enforcement at the January 14, 2003 meeting approved the following policy:

The Iowa County Social Services Department will charge the parents or guardian of a child, placed in secure detention, the full cost of the detention. If a parent or guardian is requesting that their child be placed in secure detention, they shall be advised of this policy by the placing social worker prior to the final decision to place the child. If the parent or guardian is not available to be advised of the policy, notice shall be given at the earliest opportunity subsequent to the placement.


An authority of the Iowa County Department of Social Services shall see that this requirement is included in any court order that may be made as a result of the placement.

The Iowa County Committee on Courts, Justice and Law Enforcement further authorizes the transfer of funds from the Iowa County Sheriff's Department to the Iowa County Department of Social Services for purposes of implementation of this policy.




