

RESOLUTION NO. 5-0103

TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Committee on Salary and Personnel has evaluated the scheduled hours of nurses' services in the County's Health Department:

WHEREAS, the Committee has considered the opportunity for the County Health Department to receive Wisconsin Well Woman Program grant money,

WHEREAS, the Salary & Personnel Committee and Iowa County Board of Supervisors previously approved an additional part time Public Health Nurse (17 hrs/wk) position to be added to the Health Department as recently as June 2002,

WHEREAS, an agreement was made between the Salary & Personnel Committee and Health Department Director at the time this aforementioned part time position was approved. That agreement being that in the future, additional requested and approved Public Health Nurse hours would be added to the schedule of the part time Public Health Nurse that currently is scheduled to work 28 hours per week,

WHEREAS, the Committee is in agreement with the Iowa County Health Committee in approving these 7 additional hours, with the understanding that all expenses associated with these additional hours are offset by Wisconsin Well Women's Program revenue,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Iowa County Board of Supervisors, that 7 additional hours per week be added to the regular schedule of the Public Health Nurse currently scheduled for 28 hours per week.




