Imposing the Wireless Communications Surcharges Pursuant to the Authority of Tax Law § 186-g

By Legislator

SECTION 1. Imposition of wireless communications surcharges. (a) Pursuant to the authority of Tax Law § 186-g, there are hereby imposed and there shall be paid surcharges within the territorial limits of the County of Jefferson on: (i) wireless communications service provided to a wireless communications customer with a place of primary use within such County of Jefferson, at the rate of thirty cents per month on each wireless communications device in service during any part of the month; and (ii) the retail sale of prepaid wireless communications service sold within such County of Jefferson, at the rate of thirty cents per retail sale, whether or not any tangible personal property is sold therewith.

- (b) Wireless communications service suppliers shall begin to add such surcharges to the billing of its customers and prepaid wireless communications sellers shall begin to collect such surcharge from its customers commencing December 1, 2017.
- (c) Each wireless communications service supplier and prepaid wireless communications seller is entitles to retain, as an administrative fee, an amount equal to three percent of its collections of the surcharges imposed by this resolution, provided that the supplier or seller files any required return and remits the surcharges due to the New York State Commissioner of Taxation and Finance on or before the due date for that return and that payment.
- SECTION 2. Administration of surcharges. The surcharges imposed by this resolution shall be administered and collected by the New York State Commissioner of Taxation and Finance as provided in paragraph (8) of Tax law § 186-g and in a like manner as the taxes imposed by Articles Twenty-eight and Twenty-nine of the Tax Law.
- SECTION 3. Applicability of the State law to surcharges imposed by this resolution. All the provisions of Tax Law § 186-g shall apply to the surcharges imposed by this resolution with the same force and effect as if those provisions had been set forth in full in this resolution, except to the extent that any of those provisions is either inconsistent with or not relevant to the surcharges imposed by this resolution.

SECTION 4. Net collections received by this County of Jefferson from the surcharges imposed by this resolution shall be expended only upon authorization of the Board of Legislators of the County of Jefferson and only for payment of system costs, eligible wireless 911 service costs, or other costs associated with the administration, design, installation, construction, operation, or maintenance of public safety communications networks or a system to provide

enhanced wireless 911 service serving such County of Jefferson, as provided in paragraph (9) of the Tax Law § 186-g, including, but not limited to, hardware, software, consultants, financing and other acquisition costs. The County of Jefferson shall separately account for and keep adequate books and records of the amount and object or purpose of all expenditures of all such monies. If, at the end of any fiscal year, the total amount of all such monies exceeds the amount necessary for payment of the above mentioned costs in such fiscal year, such excess shall be reserved and carried over for the payment of those costs in the following fiscal year.

SECTION 6. Effective date. This resolution shall take effect December 1, 2017.

Subject: Projected revenue from proposed Cell 911 phone surcharge

NYS authorized a public safety surcharge to be collected effective Dec. 1, 2017, and at least 90 days prior we are required to mail a certified copy of our enacting Resolution to NYS Tax Department. I asked fellow 911 Coordinators across NYS for the amount of cellular Surcharge Money that counties received in 2015 and 2016. After getting responses from six counties, I used the date from the four closest to us in population to compile Per Capita figures. The table below shows the average Per Capita figures of \$2.24 and \$2.25. Using the 2015 Per Capita figures of \$2.24 and Jefferson County's current population (2016 estimate) of 114,006 residents, would calculate to an estimated revenue of \$255,373.

It is my opinion that it will take a year or two for the phone companies to get all taxes collected properly and NYS to distribute properly. I recommend going with a lower number to not overestimate the revenue at this time, and plan to estimate \$150,000 for the 2018 budget.

I also feel that we should allocate this revenue into the cost and maintenance of the new Public Safety Radio System. When we go live, will be have to pay Onondaga County approximately \$65,000 for maintenance on the "Core" (main brain) of the system and in approximately 2021, we will begin maintenance cost on the system which is a fixed cost of \$393,500 per year until 2028. The total yearly maintenance after the warranty period on the system will be approximately \$458,500. The revenue will help to offset this very large budgetary item that would have to absorb from the General Fund.

There are 8 counties in New York State that do not collect the cell phone surcharge. They include Hamilton, Jefferson, Lewis, Oswego, Oneida, Niagara, Schoharie and St. Lawrence. I have confirmed that Lewis, Oneida, Oswego and St. Lawrence Counties are moving forward with the surcharge. Hamilton and Niagara Counties are not at this time.

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Whereas, A Project for the Replacement of Coolidge Road & CR 30 over Indian River, PIN 775359 (the "Project") is eligible for Funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-federal funds; and

Whereas, The County of Jefferson desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the federal and non-federal share of the cost of the Preliminary Engineering/Design Phases 1-4 and Right of Way Incidental Phases of the project.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, That the Jefferson County Board of Legislators does hereby approve the Project, and be it further
