Whereas, The Board of the Hudson River-Black River Regulating District, pursuant to provisions of the Environmental Conservation Law, has filed a certified statement with the Clerk of the County of Jefferson showing the name of each public corporation or a brief description of each parcel of real estate and the name of the owner, or owners, so far as can be ascertained, and the proportionate amount of the cost of storage reservoirs and the expense of maintenance and operation of such reservoirs to be borne by each parcel of real estate during the year ending June 30, 2016, and

Whereas, Pursuant to Subdivision Six of Section 15-2123 of the Environmental Conservation Law, signed into law on August 8, 1983 "...All moneys required to be collected and not paid directly to the River Regulating District by the thirty-first day of October of the year in which the assessment is levied shall be payable to the County Treasurer as provided under subdivision four of this Section and shall be subject to a service fee of one percent of the total amount assessed which shall be added to the amount to be collected and which shall be in addition to any penalties which may be imposed in the case of failure to pay general taxes within the time prescribed by law, and when collected, such penalties shall be deemed part of the assessment...".

Authorizing the Issuance by the Jefferson County Civic Facility Development Corporation (The "Issuer") of up to \$11,000,000 Aggregate Principal Amount Tax-Exempt Revenue Bonds (Samaritan Medical Center Project), Series 2015 in Accordance With Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, As Amended (The "Code") in Connection With A Certain Project (As Described Herein)

Whereas, Pursuant to a Certificate of Incorporation (the "Certificate") filed with the New York Secretary of State on the 25th day of April, 2011, the Jefferson County Civic Facility Development Corporation (the "Issuer") was duly formed under the New York Not-for-Profit Corporation Law ("N-PCL") as a not-for-profit local development corporation for the purpose of conducting activities that will relieve and reduce unemployment in Jefferson County, New York (the "County"); promote and provide for additional and maximum employment in the County; better and maintain job opportunities in the County; instruct or train individuals in the County to improve or develop their capabilities for such jobs; carry on scientific research for the purpose of aiding the County by attracting new industry to the County; or by encouraging the development of, or retention of, industry in the County; and lessening the burdens of government and acting in the public interest; and

Whereas, Pursuant to a resolution adopted April 5, 2011 (the "County Authorizing Resolution"), the Board of Legislators of the County authorized, among other things, the establishment of the Issuer pursuant to N-PCL Section 1411 to, among other things, (i) perform essential governmental functions including activities associated with job creation and the promotion of community and economic development activities within and around the County, and (ii) issue certain bonds on behalf of the County; and

Whereas, Samaritan Medical Center (the "Institution"), a New York Not-for-Profit Corporation recognized as a charitable entity pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), has presented an application (the "Application") to the Issuer, a copy of which was presented at this meeting and copies of which are on file at the office of the Issuer, requesting that the Issuer consider issuing its Revenue Bonds (Samaritan Medical Center Project) in the aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$11,000,000 (the "Series 2015 Bonds") to finance a project described below (the "Project") for the benefit of the Institution consisting of (A) the refinancing of certain indebtedness to KeyBank National Association (the "Bridge Loan") incurred to finance the acquisition of an existing 47,607 square foot 3 story medical office building and the existing improvements thereon consisting principally of an approximately 143,600 sq. ft. parking facility consisting of approximately 350 parking spaces, parking areas containing in the aggregate a capacity for approximately 192 vehicles and other related improvements (the "Existing Improvements") situated on approximately +2.7 acres of land located at 826 Washington Street and 128 Woodruff Street in the City of Watertown, Jefferson County, New York (the "Land" and, together with the Existing Improvements, the "Project

Facility"); and (B) paying certain costs and expenses incidental to the issuance of the Series 2015 Bonds; and

Whereas, By resolution adopted November 12, 2015, the Issuer authorized the scheduling and conduct of a public hearing (the "Public Hearing") to be held to qualify the issuance of Bonds by the Issuer as tax-exempt under Section 147(f) of the Code; and

Whereas, By resolution adopted November 12, 2015, the Issuer identified the Project as a "Type II" Action as defined pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act, as codified under Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law and Regulations adopted pursuant thereto by the Department of Environmental Conservation of the State (collectively, "SEQRA"), for which no formal SEQRA review is required; and

Whereas, Pursuant to and in accordance with Section 147(f) of the Code, the Issuer duly scheduled, noticed and conducted the Public Hearing on November 30, 2015, during which all interested parties were provided with an opportunity to provide verbal or written comments relative to the issuance of the Bonds by the Issuer (a copy of an affidavit of publication of a Notice of Public Hearing is attached hereto as (Exhibit A); and

Whereas, The County Board of Legislators, after due consideration of the foregoing, as the "applicable elected representative" of the County, within the meaning of Section 147(f)(2)(E) of the Code, desires to approve the issuance of the Bonds, provided the principal, premium, if any, and interest on the Bonds shall be special limited obligations of the Issuer and shall never be a debt of the State of New York (the "State") or any political subdivision thereof, including, without limitation, the County, and neither the State, nor any political subdivision thereof, including, without limitation, the County, shall be liable thereon.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of Legislators of the County of Jefferson as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of satisfying the approval requirement of Section 147(f) of the Code, the County does hereby approve the issuance by the Issuer of the Bonds for the purpose of financing the Project, provided that the Bonds, and the premium, if any, and interest thereon, shall be special limited obligations of the Issuer and shall never be a debt of the State or any political subdivision thereof, including, without limitation, the County, and neither the State nor any political subdivision thereof, including, without limitation, the County, shall be liable thereon. This approval is given pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Code for the sole purpose of qualifying the interest payable on the Bond for exclusion from gross income for federal income tax purposes pursuant to the provisions of Section 103 and 141-150 of the Code.

- Section 2. This Resolution shall be deemed to be made for the benefit of the Institution and the holders of the Bonds.
 - Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

Whereas, The Agency has leased the Facility to the Company pursuant to a Lease Agreement dated September 21, 1995 which Lease Agreement terminates on December 31, 2015, and

Whereas, Both the Agency and the Company wish to renew that Lease Agreement for an additional period of twenty (20) years ending in December 31, 2035 pursuant to an Amendment to the Lease Agreement, and

As many of these businesses have grown, they have either taken more space in the Facility or gone outside of the Facility and built their own building. Whereas, Pursuant to Section 874(1) of the Act, and Section 412(A) of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, the Agency is exempt from the payment of taxes and assessments imposed upon real property and improvements owned by it other than special ad valorem levies, special assessments and services charges against real property located in Jefferson County which are or may be imposed for special improvements or special district improvements, and

Whereas, The County of Jefferson has determined that to renew the Lease Agreement for an additional twenty (20) years ending December 31, 2035, is in the best interest of the County and deems it appropriate for the Agency to enter into a Payment in Lieu of Taxes Agreement making provision for payments in lieu of taxes by the Company to the Agency for the benefit of the respective Taxing Jurisdictions within which the property is located in substantially the same form as presented at this meeting, and
