JEFFERSON COUNTY PROBATION DEPARTMENT 2016 CHILDREN'S HOME CONTRACT RENEWAL

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES: Pursuant to County Law, section 218-1a, the Jefferson County Probation Department is designated with the responsibility for the administration of the Jefferson County Non-Secure Detention Program. We are required to provide non-secure detention facilities for the temporary boarding and care, in compliance with the Rules and Regulations of the New York State Office of Children and Family Services, of juveniles placed into the custody of the County by the Family Court pursuant to the Family Court Act, articles 3 and 7.

SPECIAL PROGRAM COMPONENTS:

- A six bed local non-secure facility with a higher level of care in a Group Home setting.
- Group Home can handle higher-risk juveniles than a foster home and allows us to keep more juveniles in Jefferson County.
- Children's Home intake coordinator available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Children's Home provides for one-on-one supervision of high-risk juveniles when needed.
- They provide us with monthly invoices and with a yearly summary of stats and costs.
- Per Diem rate is less expensive than most out-of-county facilities.
- Out-of-county transport costs have been reduced.

2015 COSTS: The contract between the Children's Home of Jefferson County and the Jefferson County Probation Department has provided us with a <u>local</u> Group Home of six beds and a 24-hour awake staff, at a current cost of \$240.00 per day. There is an additional cost of \$175.00 per day for one-on-one staff costs for times when juveniles need extra supervision in lieu of finding a bed in a secure detention facility.

For the period of January 1, 2015 through June 30, 2015, we had 0 juveniles in non-secure detention for 0 days. Our Children's Home invoices through June 30, 2015 show a cost of \$00.00 for the first six months of the year. These costs are offset by a 49% reimbursement in State Aid from the New York State Office of Children and Family Services.

The contract also includes a provision for the Children's Home to transport Non-Secure Detention juveniles to medical and counseling appointments. This has been more cost effective for us in that it allows us to keep from tying up two of our officers during this type of transport and while waiting for the child to complete the interview with the doctor or counselor.

2016 PROPOSED CONTRACT: The proposed contract between the Children's Home of Jefferson County and the Jefferson County Probation Department will again provide us with a local Group Home of six beds and a 24-hour awake staff. The per diem rate is set by the New York State Office of Children and Family Services, and is based on the actual expenses of Children's Home for the Non-Secure Detention program. Based on information from Karen Richmond, Executive Director of the Children's Home, we expect the rate for 2016 to remain at \$240.00 per day, with an additional cost of \$175.00 per day for one-on-one staff charges.

Whereas, Juvenile Delinquents (JDs), Persons in Need of Supervision (PINS), and adult sexual offenders under the supervision of the Probation Department are often ordered by the Courts to undergo sexual offender evaluation and subsequent treatment, and
Whereas, Counseling services in many instances prevent the placement of JDs and PINS in esidential treatment, and adults from re-offending thereby saving Jefferson County a much greater cost.
Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, That Jefferson County enter into an agreement with Insights Forensic Counseling, Inc. for the provision of court ordered sexual offender psychological esting, evaluation and recommendations for treatment of Juvenile Delinquents, Persons in Need of Supervision, and adult offenders. The contract period shall commence on January 1, 2016 and erminate on December 31, 2016. JEFFERSON COUNTY PROBATION DEPARTMENT 2016 INSIGHTS FORENSIC COUNSELING, INC. RENEWAL

We are requesting a Board of Legislators resolution to be allowed to renew our contract with Insights Forensic Counseling, Inc for Court ordered adult and juvenile sexual offender evaluations, assessments, treatment, and counseling.

For the juveniles, treatment components consist of individual and group therapy for the youth; and family therapy to include all or parts of the family. They also stress group therapy for the parents to provide a support network and a forum to teach them the information that the youth are learning. The program coordinates with any available home-based therapy to assist the family in using the skills they have learned, address issues that exist for the family in the community and school, and be available for crisis intervention services.

Part of the program's purpose is to identify which elements of the family system contributing to sexually abusive behavior are not working, and to help the family modify these dysfunctional elements in order to heal the pain of sexual abuse.

A relapse prevention approach is specifically designed to increase the youth's awareness and range of choices concerning their behavior, and to develop specific coping skills and self-control to prevent a return to the offensive conduct.

Insights Forensic Counseling, Inc. is also certified for the treatment of adult sexual offenders and the program will now be utilized to provide court ordered evaluations, assessments and treatment for adult sexual offenders.

In order to provide these services, we have a Professional Fees line in our budget. This line is also used for Rubenzahl, Knudsen and Associates psychological evaluations and counseling.

2015 COSTS:

From January 1, 2015 through June 30, 2015, we had 32 juvenile and adult Probationers receive services for evaluations and counseling at a cost of \$38,975.00 for the period. We request that parents and adult Probationers make full payment or a reasonable co-payment if possible.

2016 PROPOSED CONTRACT:

The Insights Forensic Counseling rates for 2016 will increase to \$80.00 per hour for evaluation and individual counseling; \$47.50 per hour for group counseling; \$350 for requested juvenile evaluations, and \$75.00 per hour when providing testimony in court relative to the services performed under the contract. The total compensation for the period of this contract shall not exceed the sum of \$95,000.00.
