Supporting Necessary Reforms to New York Labor Law §240 and §241

Whereas, New York Labor Law §240 and §241, commonly known as the "Scaffold Law," outlines liability for injuries caused by an employee's fall from a height, and

Whereas, The laws impose strict liability on employers and owners of buildings if a worker falls from any height, and

Whereas, The law was first imposed in 1885 at a time when worker safety was largely neglected in New York State and at a time when modern safety equipment and scaffolding techniques did not exist, and

Whereas, The Scaffold Law has caused a dramatic increase in construction costs due to increased insurance required for employers in the construction business, causing New York State to have the highest general liability insurance costs in the nation, and

Whereas, Half of the 30 largest law suits in the state stem from Scaffold Law issues while, at the same time, scaffold related injuries have steadily decreased over the past 20 years, and

Whereas, New York is the only state in the country to impose a construction law like the Scaffold Law that imposes strict liability on the employer; further it is one of a very few laws that mandate strict liability in the State of New York, and

Whereas, The increase in costs in New York drives away investment in our infrastructure when developers and contractors can get better rates in other states, and

Whereas, Not only does the law drive away out-of-state investment in infrastructure but the lost investment to other states also serves to decrease the number of new construction jobs created every year, making it more difficult for many of New York's skilled laborers to find appropriate employment, and

Whereas, Federal regulations have been enacted that attempt to protect workers from injury to falls by requiring certain precautions to be in place for people working at heights and allows an outlet for workers concerned about their safety to engage federal review of any worksite for compliance with these regulations.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, That the Jefferson County Board of Legislators is strongly in support of Scaffold Law reform as well as meaningful protection of construction workers by repealing or modifying the existing Scaffold Law in New York State, and be it further

Requesting Introduction of Legislation for the Authorization of a One Percent Increase in the County Sales and Compensating Use Tax in Jefferson County

Whereas, By Resolution Nos. 135, and 169 of 2004, this Board of Legislators requested the introduction of a bill in the State Legislature to amend the New York State Tax Law to allow the County of Jefferson to impose an additional sales tax of three quarters of one percent (3/4%) through November 30, 2005, and following introduction of legislation concurred in and authorized the home rule request of the Chairman of this Board for its enactment; said legislation was subsequently passed by the State Legislature and signed into law by the Governor, and
Whereas, By Resolution Nos. 32 and 114 of 2005, Resolution Nos. 31 and 115 of 2007, Resolutions Nos. 32 and 95 of 2009, Resolution Nos. 48 and 104 of 2011, Resolution Nos. 97 and 138 of 2013 this Board of Legislators requested the introduction of a bill in the State Legislature to amend the New York State Tax Law to allow the County of Jefferson to impose an additional sales tax of three quarters of one percent (3/4%) through November 30, 2007, November 30, 2009, November 30, 2011, November 30, 2013, and November 30, 2015 respectively; and following introduction of legislation concurred in and authorized the home rule request of the Chairman of this Board for its enactment; and said legislation was subsequently passed by the State Legislature and signed into law by the Governor, and
Whereas, The County requires an increase to one percent of said sales tax revenue in order to continue to stabilize the property tax levy and retain important local government services.
