Authorizing Agreement with POMCO Group for the Administration of New Workers' Compensation Claims

Whereas, The administrative and reporting requirements and costs of the County Workers' Compensation Plan are growing, and
Whereas, There are several retirements expected in the Insurance Department in the next few years, and
Whereas, For planning purposes, it is prudent to look for assistance in the administration and reporting of new workers' compensation claims from a third party, and
Whereas, The POMCO Group is a New York State licensed workers' compensation claims third party administrator and has provided a proposal to the County for said services, and
Whereas, The Director of Insurance recommends entering into an agreement with the POMCO group for said services for \$25,000 for 2015, with optional one-year extensions dependent on mutual agreements as to yearly fee increases, and
Whereas, Said funding is included in the 2015 County Budget.

In addition, for the entire contract period, summer rental rates for tandem-axle dump trucks shall be \$50 per hour, single-axle trucks shall be \$20 per hour, mowers shall be \$5 per hour above the DOT rate, and all other equipment shall be reimbursed at the DOT rates in effect at the time of their use.
