SOLID WASTE

Budget Adjustment - Unanticipated Revenues

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-1605 provides that the Board of County Commissioners may adjust the budget as adopted to reflect the receipt of unscheduled revenue, grants, or donations from federal, state or local governments or private sources, provided that there shall be no increase in anticipated property taxes; and

WHEREAS, Solid Waste has received unexpected revenue in the amount of \$285,128.63 from regular operations fees for FY 2016; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Bonner County, Idaho hereby authorizes the Clerk to schedule revenue in the FY2016 budget, line item# 0023-00-0468-0004 (Disposal – Waste Management) by \$285,128.63 from \$683,351 to \$968,479.63. These funds could not have been anticipated or budgeted for.
