Attention: Lakeshore Development Requirement

The City of McCall is proud to be working in collaboration with both the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and the Big Payette Lake Watershed Advisory Group (WAG) to promote higher water quality in Big Payette Lake. In an attempt to promote water quality the City of McCall is implementing a new requirement for any type of development in the Shoreline Zone (a 150' strip of land around both Payette Lakes, North Fork of the Payette River, and Lake Fork Creek).

Starting May 22, 2008 contractors working in the Shoreline Zone will be required to have valid stormwater and erosion certification (see details below).

REQUIREMENT EXPLANATION

The certification requirement will have four main aspects. After the enactment date of May 22, 2008, the following:

- 1) Contractors wishing to submit a building permit application for any development within the Shoreline Zone shall be certified.
- 2) The certified contractor listed on an application shall furnish proof of certification at the time of application submittal.
- 3) The certified contractor listed on an application shall be held responsible in the event of any EPA or DEQ enforcement action (including the transgression of non-certified individuals working on the project).

* The City of McCall will recognize other national and regional stormwater and erosion certifications with proof of certification.
