The "**Flood of Love**" Community Potluck Dinner is this Saturday, August 3rd at 6:00 pm in Swensson Park. This dinner is for the community to come together in the aftermath of the flood for a time of sharing and fellowship. Those affected by the flood, first responders and the volunteers are invited to come and rest, relax, eat...and feel the love. The entire community is invited and is asked to bring a chair, table service and a covered dish. Live entertainment will be provided.

A Lindsborg Flood Relief fund has been established at Peoples Bank and Trust. Cash and check donations may be sent or delivered to the bank which is located at 201 South Main Street, Lindsborg, Kansas 67456. The fund is being administered by TACOL (The Associated Churches of Lindsborg) with 100% of the funds going to benefit the victims of the flood.

Lindsborg is currently in a Flash Flood Watch until 1:00 pm until Sunday, August 4th. The City of Lindsborg has restocked sand and sand bags. To minimize hoarding of sand bags and to ensure they get to where they are needed, in the event of an eminent flood they will be delivered to the area that is being threatened. Residents are also asked to stay tuned to weather forecasts and take the appropriate precautions in the event of threatening weather. City Hall will be open Saturday, August 3rd from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. There are still weather radios available for Lindsborg residents at no charge. If you are a Lindsborg resident and your household has not picked up a weather radio, please come by City Hall on Saturday and pick one up.
