The City of Lindsborg is holding a Public Information Meeting for the citizens affected by the of July 29th flood. The meeting will focus on flood remediation efforts, resources for assistance, plus sanitation and health issues associated with a flood. It will be held in the Smoky Valley Middle School Auditorium located at 401 North Cedar. City officials, Kansas Department of Emergency Management representatives, and Red Cross officials will be present to discuss the flood and answer questions from those impacted. The meeting will be Thursday, August 1st at 7:00 p.m.

The preliminary property damage assessment is currently \$3.8 million. There are residents in the community outside the northwest portion of town who experienced flooding. We need your help in identifying them to determine their damage and assess their needs. Any residents that have experience flood damage are outside northwest part of town and a city or Red Cross official has not made contact with you, please call City Hall at 785-227-3355 to notify us.
