PAVEMENT, CURB & GUTTER REMOVAL POLICY

When it becomes necessary for the owner of a water, sewer or electric service to repair or install a line which is located under an existing paved street or alley, the following policy shall apply;

The City will cut and remove the curb and gutter, and street surface and dispose of same at no cost to the owner. The owner is responsible for the excavation, service line work and the recompaction of the removed material. If the owner chooses not to recompact the backfill material, they may, at their own expense, use flowable-fill up to the existing sub-grade elevation. The City will be responsible for replacement of the paving.

All dirt work including backfilling, seeding and leveling will be the responsibility of the owner.

EXCEPTION TO THIS POLICY – Whenever a service, other than a city owned utility, is required to have service work performed, for example; gas line repair, telephone line repair, cable TV repair etc., the entire cost including equipment, labor, and materials will be charged to the responsible utility.
