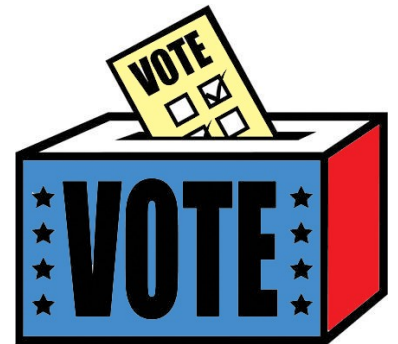

Effective February 16th, The Town of Pantego will be switching credit card payment processing companies to nCourt to provide enhanced security measures for our customers. nCourt will provide payment processing services via the web, mobile device, 24/7 live, bilingual call center and in person at Town Hall. Residents and business owners will now be able to make a credit card payment online or by phone for utility billing, permitting fees, fire inspections and other payments. This service will be provided for the convenience of the users at a \$4.95 fee for utility billing and 3.5% fee for other general payments. Payments for these services will still be accepted at Town Hall by check, money order, cash or credit card. The processing fee for credit cards will still apply even if paid in person. The option for electronic bank draft is also still available.

Election Season has begun!

The 2017 Pantego Municipal Election will be held on Saturday, May 5, 2018 at the Council Chamber in Town Hall and will be for Council Places 1, 2 and 3. Beginning January 17, 2018, candidate applications will be available on the Town's website, Secretary of State's website, or can be picked up anytime at Town Hall Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The deadline to file the Candidate Application is Friday, February 16, 2018 by 5:00 p.m. The application must be physically brought to Town Hall for filing. Keep in mind the application will be reviewed for completeness and if deemed incomplete will be returned to the applicant to complete. Should an incomplete application be filed at 5:00 p.m. on the deadline date, the application will remain incomplete and unfiled so be sure to get your application in early. WaterSmart

Cold weather is here! Make sure to prepare by covering outdoor faucets with Styrofoam faucet covers or wrapping faucets with heavy cloth covered by plastic. You should also locate your emergency master shut off valve (usually found in a flower bed near the front of the house) so that you can quickly shut off the water to your house if any pipes happen to freeze and burst while they are thawing. Disconnect and store your garden hoses to help prevent busted pipes and cracked outdoor faucets.
