In an effort to "Keep Pantego Beautiful", there are several steps you can take to keep your property in compliance with Town Ordinances. Examples of common code violations include:

- Grass that exceeds 12 inches in height or is more than 4 inches over the curb.
- Tree branches and growth that are less than 14 ft. above the street and less than 7 ft. above sidewalks and parkways.
- Swimming pools that are not clean or maintained.
- Unsanitary yards or businesses. (trash or debris not picked up, etc.)

Please be considerate of your neighbors and take steps to remedy these situations if they occur on your property.
