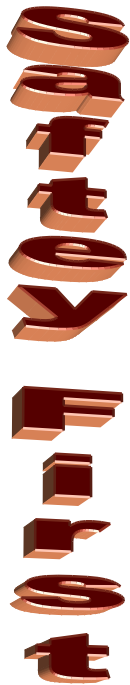

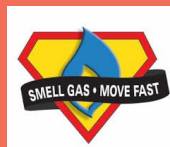
Election Season has begun!

The 2018 Pantego Municipal Election will be held on Saturday, May 5, 2018 at the Council Chamber in Town Hall and will be for Council Places 1, 2 and 3. Beginning January 17, 2018, candidate applications will be available on the Town's website, Secretary of State's website, or can be picked up anytime at Town Hall on

Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The deadline to file the candidate application is Friday, February 16, 2018 by 5 p.m. The application must be physically delivered to Town Hall for filing. Keep in mind the application will be reviewed for completeness and if deemed incomplete will be returned to the applicant to complete. Should an incomplete application be filed at 5:00 p.m. on the deadline date, the application will remain incomplete and unfiled so be sure to get your application in early. - Make sure you have working smoke and carbon monoxide detectors and the batteries powering them are fresh.
- Carbon monoxide poisoning can result from a malfunctioning heating unit or another fuel-burning appliance, as well as from a blocked chimney.
- Never use a generator, grill, stove or other fossil fuel burning devices inside a home, garage or other enclosed areas. NEVER heat a home with an oven even if your electricity goes out.
- Use extra caution when using space heaters. Place a space heater on a level, hard surface and keep anything flammable (such as paper, clothing, bedding, curtains or rugs) at least three feet away from the unit.



- Be aware that Atmos adds an odorant, which smells like rotten eggs, to natural gas to help you detect a leak. The odorant is added in small concentrations and is harmless. If you smell and odor of rotten eggs, leave the building immediately, taking everyone with you. Do not use the phone, light a match or switch anything on or off. Leave the door open, and once clear of the area call 911 from your cell phone or neighbor's home.
