Annual Easter Egg & Scavenger Hunt Event

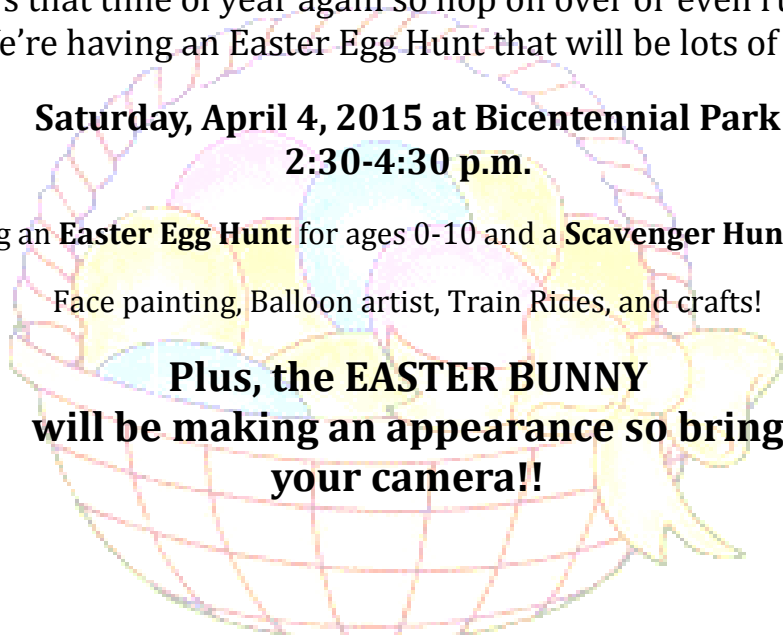
It's that time of year again so hop on over or even run...

The event is scheduled for Monday, May 25th, at Bicentennial Park. More information on this event coming soon.

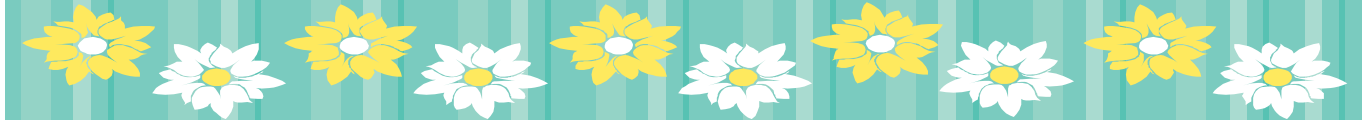

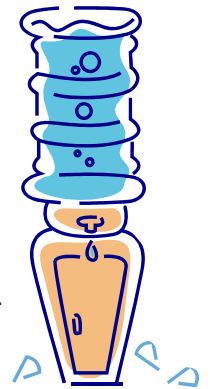
Website Update

Tips for Water Conservation

- When waiting for cold tap water to warm up, capture wasted water in a pitcher or watering can to water plants.
- A faucet that drips can waste up to 3,820 gallons of water per year. A leaky toilet can waste 200 gallons of water per day. Most leaks are easy to repair. Fix that leak!
- Want to save 3-5 gallons per minute? Turn off the tap when brushing your teeth.
- Install water-saving fixtures. Aerated faucets, efficient toilets and shower heads can save you thousands of gallons of water per year.
- Only run the dishwasher or washing machine when you have a full load.
- Limit outdoor water use by ensuring that you are only watering the lawn, not sidewalks or the road.
- Reduce lawn watering by planting native, drought-resistant plants.
