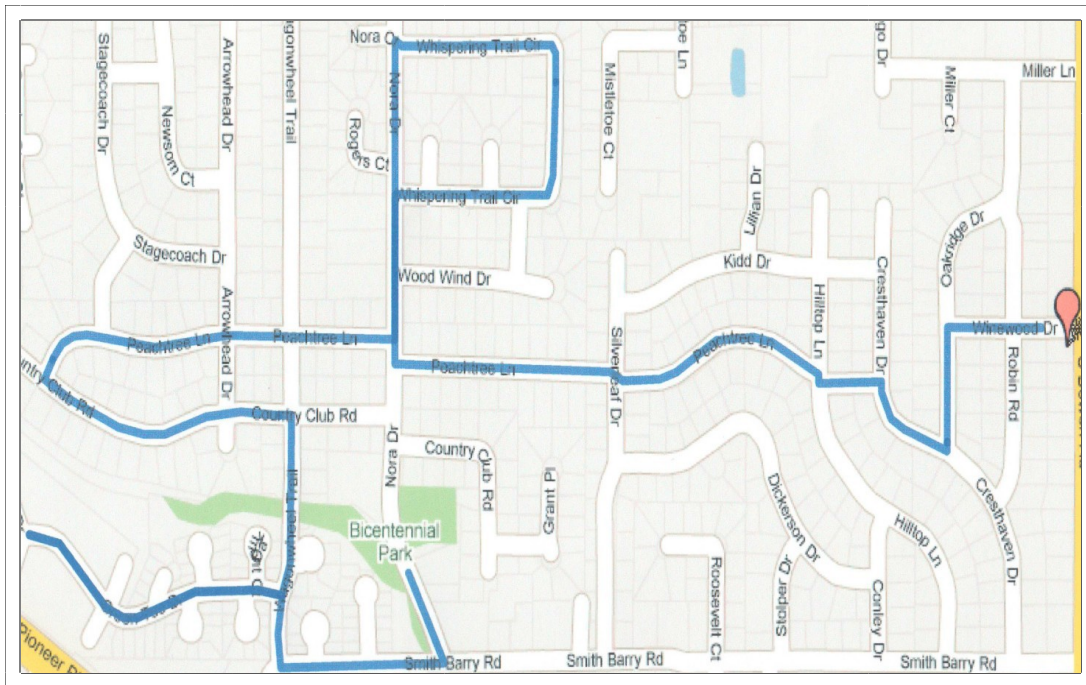

### CONSTRUCTION PROJECT UPDATES:

- The Wagonwheel Waterline, Wastewater and Bridge project will be complete by the end of November. It is anticipated the street will be accessible for the Thanksgiving holiday weekend. At the beginning of the year, the Town will be working with Tarrant County to schedule the street overlay which will include all of Wagonwheel from W Park Row to Smith Barry.
