Clean Up Day is Coming! Saturday, April 12th, 2014!

Our clean up day will collect trash and hazardous waste materials. Regular trash collection will be held from 8am-4pm in the south-west parking lot at the intersection of Winewood and Bowen Rd. Brush collection will stop at 3pm. The hazardous waste collection will be held from 8am-12pm in the parking lot at Town Hall.

Please be sure to bring your ID since we will be verifying your residency. Be aware that this is a first come first serve basis. Once our collection bins are full, we cannot accept additional materials. Please note that the hazardous waste collection does not last all day, this event will end at 12:00pm, or when full.

Accepted Materials: Flammables, toxic liquid, corrosive acids, latex paints, most home appliances, electronic equipment and more.

Materials NOT Accepted: Medical waste (pills, needles, etc.), smoke detectors and tires.

Utility Bills: We have a Bank Draft option!

Tired of keeping track of due dates? Fed up with late fees? Sign up for our automatic bank draft! Signing up for bank draft allows for your monthly bill to be drafted directly out of your bank account by the Town. This will ensure your payment has been made on time and successfully. If you would like to apply, please fill out a bank draft application (applications can be found on our website www.townofpantego.com under Forms & Permits, or at Town Hall). In addition to your application, we will need a voided check. Once we have your application, we can enroll your utility account and start drafting the monthly balance directly from your bank account. If you have any additional questions or concerns, please contact Town Hall at (817) 617-3700. In addition to bank draft, we can also process a credit or debit card over the phone, no service fee applied. We do not accept American Express.
