Missing or Found Animals

The Town of Pantego Public Works Department is responsible for animal control and works with the City of Fort Worth to provide shelter to animals that are found loose in town away from their homes. When an animal is dropped off at the Fort Worth facility, they are assigned an animal ID number and the rightful owner has **five days** to claim their animal. That ID number will be needed to either claim the pet as yours, or adopt the pet from the shelter. **If the pet is yours, the shelter fees will need to be paid to the town at Town Hall before picking up your pet.** The receipt will need to be presented to the shelter to get your animal back.



If you are an animal owner whose pet has been taken to the animal shelter, it is imperative you claim your pet as soon as possible. After the five day impoundment period has lapsed and the pet has not been claimed, the decision to whether the pet is kept and put up for adoption is dependent upon facility space limitations.

Citizens are required to register their pets with the Town which helps avoid pets being taken to Fort Worth should they get away from their homes. Pet registrations are available at Town Hall for a low annual fee.
