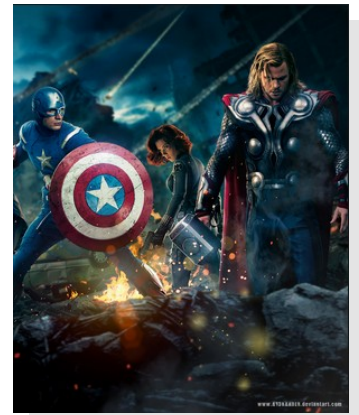
## **\*\* MOVIE NIGHT EVENT IN BICENTENNIAL PARK \*\***

## **MOSQUITO AWARENESS INFORMATION!**

We would encourage all residents to be aware of the conditions that promote mosquito breeding and take precautions to prevent them. Due to the positive responses we received from citizens after the first spray application, staff has been instructed by the Town Council to spray the entire town in the very near future.

The Town of Pantego Municipal Services is continually monitoring the mosquito population for large numbers and the presence of West Nile Virus. In the event we cannot reduce the mosquito population through education and larvicide application, or if we detect the presence of West Nile virus among the mosquito population, the entire town will receive ground spraying. Ground spraying has been determined to be harmless to humans and animals as applied. Residents who have questions or concerns in regards to ground spraying are encouraged to obtain a copy of the literature available at Town Hall or on the Town web site.



# TAKE CONTROL

## Stop West Nile Virus



- At least once or twice a week, dump water from flowerpots, a pet's food and water dishes, birdbaths, swimming pool covers, buckets, barrels and cans.
- Check children's toys and wading pools; dump out any water.
- Turn over things like wheelbarrows and buckets to keep them from collecting water.
- Check for clogged rain gutters and clean them out.
- Remove discarded tires, and other items that could collect water.
- Be sure to check for containers or trash that may collect water in places that may be hard to see, such as under bushes or under your home.
