Judging will occur the weekend of December 13th-15th.

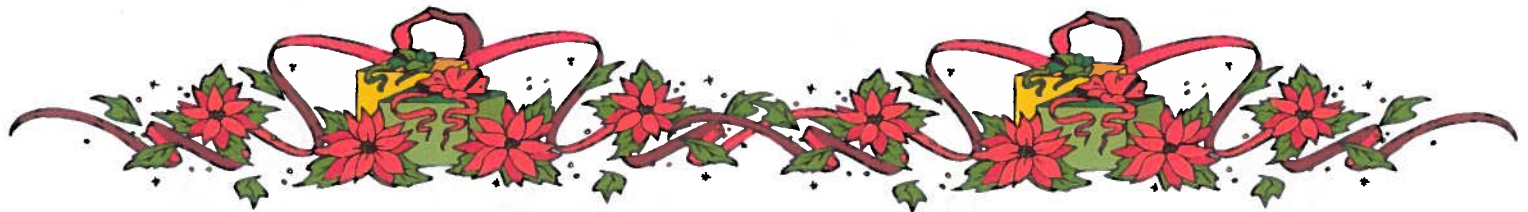
Judges will be local area businesses and the Community Relations Board.

The 303 beautification project is moving along nicely. Irrigation for the medians is being installed and the taps for the irrigation will be made in the next couple of weeks. The project is scheduled to be completed by early to mid December.
