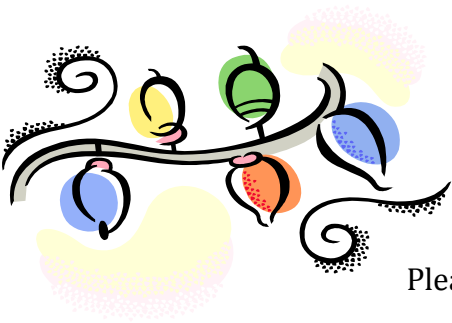

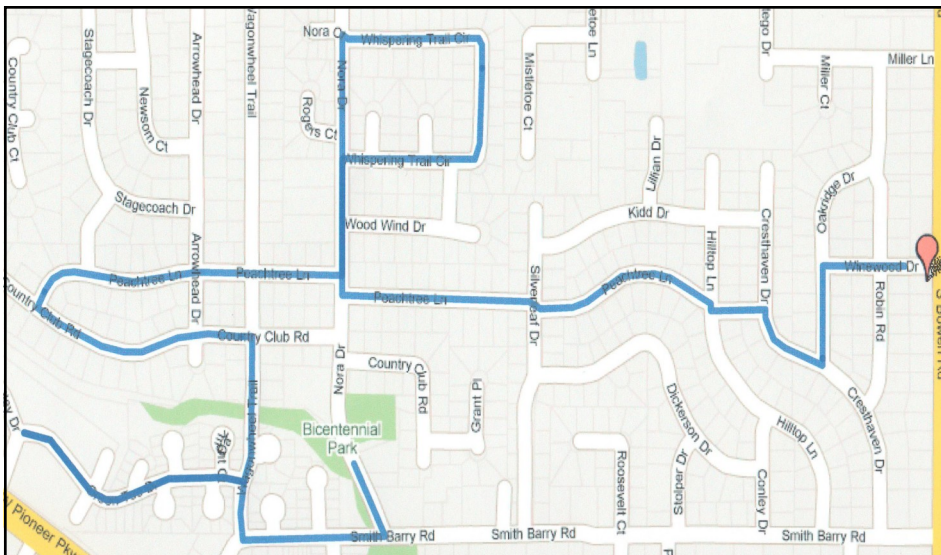


## Candy Train & Tree Lighting ❄️ Holiday In the Park!
