City and Borough of Sitka Building Department Standard permit fees for certain projects

Policy #02-01

Effective Date: April 3, 2002

Purpose: To establish uniform permit fees for certain projects

Background: This policy formalizes a historical practice of the Building Department.

The Sitka General Code requires that permit fees and plan review fees be based on project value, and that project value be assigned by the Building Official. In the interest of uniformity, permit fees for certain projects are set by the Building

Official as follows.

Commercial membrane structure placement, no electrical service.	\$115

Temporary electrical service for job shack	No Fee
Residential grading, including rock walls, concrete retaining walls, engineered rock walls, and engineered concrete retaining walls, which are not part of a building	\$65
Fences over eight (8) feet in height which require a permit	\$25
Electrical service replacement - no change in size of service	\$25
Demolition of commercial building (no inclusion of demolition in building permit)	\$75
Demolition of residential building, R-3 or U occupancy (no inclusion of demolition in building permit)	\$25
School project by student, project value less than \$2,000.	\$0
LPG tank installation, not part of another project - residential	\$25
LPG tank installation, not part of another project - commercial	\$75
Helical pier foundation remediation- Use project value for building permit fee determination with project value for fee calculation capped at \$10,000.00. Moved structure – 25% of valuation for new construct ion.
