FOR SCHOOL BOARD TWO to be elected Vote for no more than 2	Informational: An affirmative vote of this ballot proposition would exempt the City and Borough of Sitka from the provisions of AS 18.35.301 – 18.35.350, relating to smoking in certain public places. In that case, Sitka General Code, Chapter 9.20, entitled "Smoking in Public Places and Places of Public Employment", would remain in effect. Under Chapter 9.20, smoking is prohibited or regulated in certain public places. However, under Chapter 9.20, smoking is not prohibited or regulated in "bars" and "private clubs", except if declared by the establishment as "nonsmoking." If the question is rejected, the new law, AS 18.35.301 – 18.35.350, would prohibit smoking in certain enclosed public places, including "bars" and "private clubs".
