**PROPOSITION NO. 1**

**\$7,000,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS TO FINANCE  
ROAD RECONSTRUCTION, IMPROVEMENTS AND  
REPAIRS**

Shall the City and Borough of Sitka incur debt and issue general obligation bonds in the principal amount of not to exceed seven million dollars (\$7,000,000), maturing within a maximum of 20 years, to finance road reconstruction, improvements and repairs, and shall Ordinance No. 2009-70 of the City and Borough authorizing the issuance of the bonds for this roads project be approved?

The bonds will be issued only to the extent that a sales tax rate increase for the Roads project, as described in the related sales tax rate Proposition No. 2, is approved by the voters of the City and Borough of Sitka.

**PROPOSITION NO. 2**

**INCREASE SALES TAX RATE ONE-HALF OF ONE  
PERCENT (.5%) ALL YEAR AROUND FOR FINANCING  
ROADS RECONSTRUCTION, IMPROVEMENTS AND  
REPAIRS**

Shall the City and Borough of Sitka have a sales tax rate increase of one-half of one percent all year around starting on January 1, 2010, which is currently at five percent (5%) from October 1 through March 31, and six percent (6%) from April 1 through September 30, to pay for an estimated seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) in City and Borough of Sitka roads and streets reconstruction, improvements and repairs?

**Informational:** This proposition would increase sales tax to 5.5% October through March and to 6.5% from April through September each year until the bonds are paid off. This sales tax increase shall **ONLY** take effect if the voters pass both Proposition No. 1. and Proposition No. 2.
