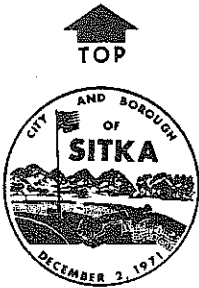

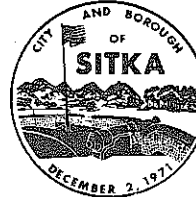

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall Section 13.03 PROPERTY TAX LIMIT be amended to read: Any ordinance levying ad valorem property taxes for any fiscal year in excess of seven tenths of one percent (.007%) of the assessed valuation of the property to be taxed shall not be valid until ratified by at least sixty percent of the voters registered to vote in municipal elections, at a general or special election held in the area affected, or unless a ballot proposition specifically authorizing such a seven mill tax levy to be exceeded is approved by at least sixty percent of the voters registered to vote in municipal elections within the 24 months previous to the levy increase?
