"SHALL THERE BE ESTABLISHED A SERVICE AREA TO BE OPERATED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE GREATER SITKA BOROUGH WITH THE POWER TO PROVIDE THE SERVICES OF WATER, POWER, FIRE PROTECTION, AND COLLECTION AND TREATMENT OF SEWAGE IN THAT AREA OF THE GREATER SITKA BOROUGH, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Beginning at a point where the southwesterly boundary of the Old Sitka Historical Site, Lot 2, U.S. Survey No. 3670, intersects with the mean low water line of Sitka Sound,

Thence in a southerly direction along the mean low water line of Sitka Sound to its intersection with the boundary of the Tongass National Forest situated between Thimbleberry Bay and Silver Bay,

Thence in a northerly direction along the boundary of the Tongass National Forest to its intersection with the southwesterly boundary of the Old Sitka Historical Site, Lot 2, U.S. Survey No. 3670,

Thence in a northwesterly direction along the boundary of the Old Sitka Historical Site, Lot 2, U.S. Survey No. 3670, to its intersection with the mean low water line of Sitka Sound, the place of beginning,

Excepting therefrom all that area within the City of Sitka, Alaska.
