Section 1. Section 3.5 of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Sitka, Alaska is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3.5 Other Officers. Additional officers of the City shall be a city clerk-treasurer, a chief of police, a fire chief, a city attorney, a city magistrate (in the absence of a duly appointed district magistrate or deputy district magistrate as provided in Chapter 184, S.L.A. 1959) and such other officers as the council deems necessary. Each of these officers shall be appointed and may be suspended or removed by the mayor with the consent of the council. The council may combine the positions of chief of police and fire chief or any two or more appointive city offices not inconsistent with each other. The council may designate any appointive officer to supervise any other appointive officer except the city magistrate in the exercise of his judicial function."

Section 2. Section 5.3 of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Sitka, Alaska as stated below is hereby repealed.
