"Shall the City of Sitka, Alaska, be authorized to issue revenue bonds payable only from the unpledged revenues of it's municipal water and electric utility systems in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00 and bearing interest not to exceed six percent per annum, in addition to \$5,000,000.00 of such bonds previously authorized by Ordinance No. 181 of said City, and an election held therein on March 11, 1957, for the purpose of providing funds to pay the cost of extending, improving and making permanent additions to said systems, including the purchase or construction of a dam impounding the water of Blue Lake, facilities for conducting said water to a hydro-electric generating plant on Medvetcha River, constructing and equipping such hydro-electric plant, water and electric supply, transmission and distribution facilities, and additional diesel generating plant and equipment, lands for all such facilities and all expenses incidental thereto; the issuance and sale of said bonds and the acquisition of said extensions, improvements and additions to be limited to such amounts, on such terms and to such facilities as the Common Council shall authorize by ordinance from time to time."
