Canvass of the ballots of the Special Election held June 5, 1956, showed 248 cast with one vote rejected, and 241 votes for bonds and 6 against. Mr. Fnight regularly moved that the report of the election board be accepted. Fr. Andersen seconded and the motion carried.

PROPOSITION

Shall the City of Sitka, Alaska, issue its revenue bonds in the principal sum of not to exceed \$5,000,000.00, such bonds to be payable solely from unpledged revenues of the public works for which such bonds are issued including future additions and improvements, such bonds to bear interest at a rate of not to exceed 5% per annum and to mature serially or otherwise as the Common Council may by ordinance provide, but not to exceed 30 years from date of issue, for the purpose of providing funds to construct a hydroelectric plant with dam, generating and distributing facilities, water storage and facilities for sale of water, said dam to be constructed at the Blue Lake power site located approximately eight miles southeast of Sitka, Alaska, all as more specifically provided in Resolution No. 197 of the Common Council of the City of Sitka, Alaska.
