Shall the City of Sitka, Alaska, incur indebtedness in the sum of \$500,000.00 for the purpose of acquiring the following public work of a permanent nature: Construction and equipping of a one-story concrete block building with reinforced concrete foundation; to be constructed by the United States of America and sold to the City of Sitka at a price not in excess of \$500,000.00, said indebtedness to bear interest not exceeding 2% per annum, to be evidenced by a Project Construction and Sales Agreement between the City of Sitka and the United States and by General Obligation bonds, with interest thereon at 2% per annum payable semi-annually, if the United States so required, and in any event by a pledge of the full faith and credit of the City of Sitka, Alaska, all as provided by Ordinance No. 144 of the City of Sitka passed and approved the 6th day of November, 1951.
