SHALL ORDINANCE No. 132 BE RATIFIED?

The terms of this Ordinance authorize the sale of a plot of land, no longer needed for municipal purposes, to the Cathedral Building Corporation, for the sole purpose of enlarging the site now owned by said Corporation sufficiently to allow the construction of a seven story, thirty-five unit apartment and store building.

The land to be sold is described as: That portion of land approximately 120 feet in length and varying in width from 10 feet to 30 feet, bounded by the southerly property lines of Lots 1, 3, 4 and C-49 in Block 5 and the existing curved sidewalk on Lincoln Street, and by the easterly property line of U.S. Survey No. 404 - Tract K of Block 5 and the street line of Cathedral Way.

The land shall be sold for \$1.00 and other considerations, with the proviso that in the event of the failure of the Corporation to complete the proposed structure within a period of three years, the title shall revert to the City of Sitka.
