PROPOSITION NO. 1

Proposition No. 1. ratified or rejected Ordinance No. 128 setting the terms for Mayors at two years and for Councilmen at three years. Rejection by the voters automatically sets all terms at one year.

Proposition No. 2. authorized the Council to continue to levy a 2% sales tax for Public Health and Educational purposes.
