The meeting was called to order at 3:00P.M. by Acting Mayor Rands, present were councilmen, Price, Hagen, Beach, Johnson.

Clerk presented the returns of the Special Election of Tuesday Sept. 14, 1943 at which the tax payers voted on the issue of \$70,000.00 of bonds.

Election carried in favor of issuing bonds.

Johnson moved and Beach 2nd to accept the returns of the election. Johnson, yes; Beach, yes; Price, yes; Hagen, yes; motion carried.

Ordinance No. 105 was read by the clerk, pertaining to the issuance of \$70,000.00 of bonds at 4% interest in the denomination of \$500 each.

SPECIAL ELECTION

TO THE ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF SITKA, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION:

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to law and Resolution No. 81 passed by the Common Council of the Town of Sitka, Alaska, a municipal corporation, at its regular meeting held on July 27, 1943, a SPECIAL ELECTION will be held in the said Town of Sitka, Alaska, on September 14, 1943 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. of said day, at which election the electors of and in the said incorporated Town of Sitka are invited to vote on the following question or proposition, to wit:

"Whether or not the Incorporated Town of Sitka shall issue bonds in a sum, not exceeding Seventy Thousand dollars (\$70,000.00) for the purpose of making certain municipal improvements within the Town of Sitka, Alaska."

That the entire area embraced within the corporate limits of the said Town of Sitka, shall constitute one voting precinct, and that the polling place shall be that certain public office known as the Town of Sitka office situated on Lincoln Street near Maksoutoff Street, in the said Town of Sitka. All persons who are citizens of the United States, twenty-one years of age or over, who have been residents of Alaska for the period of one year and of the Town of Sitka for thirty days immediately preceeding the date of said election, who have duly registered as provided by the Election Ordinance of the Town of Sitka, and whose names appear on the last Assessment Roll of the said Town for municipal taxation, are qualified to vote at said election.
