

The following summary of legislation passed by Dover City Council at its regular meeting the 5th day of March 2018 is published once to comply with the Ohio Revised Code. A full copy of the text can be obtained or viewed at the Office of the Mayor of the City of Dover. Emergency ordinance 7-18. An emergency ordinance to approve the vacation of West Fifth Street between Walnut and Tuscarawas Avenue and a portion of Cherry Alley from Hickory Alley northwest to the terminus, and an unnamed alley between Cherry Alley and North Walnut Street from Hickory Alley to West Fifth Street for the purpose of constructing the new Dover High School as recommended by the Dover Planning Commission on January 9, 2018. Emergency ordinance 11-18. An emergency ordinance to authorize the Director of Public Safety to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the construction of the north end satellite fire station and satellite police field office based upon estimates and drawings on file with the Director of Public Safety offices and in an amount not to exceed 1.65 million dollars. Emergency ordinance 12-18. An emergency ordinance of the City of Dover, Ohio to approve the assignment of a portion of the municipality's interest in the Fremont Power sales contract with American Municipal Power, Inc. to the Delaware Municipal Electric Corporation and taking other actions in connection therewith. Ordinance 13-18. A permanent appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2018. For the City of Dover, Ohio. Emergency ordinance 14-18. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Service Director to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the installation of approximately 720 lineal feet of 8 inch diameter ductile iron waterline on Front Street between Fairview Avenue and High Street, in an amount not to exceed \$99,000.00, including engineering. The Clerk of Council will supply a copy of the complete text with a written request and payment of a fee of .10 cents per page.

A resolution to thank the Dover Moose Lodge # 707 for its generous donation of \$3,554.76 for the Dover Police and Fire Departments and expressing the Dover Council and Administration's appreciation for this generous gift. Emergency ordinance 15-18. An emergency ordinance authorizing the expenditure of funds for service and parts to be expended during the outage of the power plant in the spring of 2018 for the rebuild of the boiler, to do work to keep the plant in good working order, and to facilitate continued compliance necessary for operation and production of power at the Dover Light and Power Plant from sole source providers in an estimated amount of \$285,000.00 and declaring an emergency under ORC 735.051. Emergency ordinance 16-18. An emergency ordinance authorizing the expenditure of funds for service to be acquired to test and demonstrate compliance with environmental standards immediately after the shutdown during mandatory testing and reporting and to complete and submit the scope of work in the proposal P183601.0035-2018 on file with the Director of Public Service and in an amount not to exceed \$45,000.00 as provided and to declare an emergency under ORC 735.051 and a total amount for the year estimated at \$60,000.00 for compliance monitoring and testing when additional compliance and reporting are required for compliance with mandatory reporting agencies.
