An emergency ordinance wherein compensation is established for identified non-bargaining positions of employment for the calendar years 2018, 2019 and 2020; creating pay grades and pay ranges for such employees applicable to the years 2018, 2019 and 2020; and placing certain conditions on compensation rates for such employees. Emergency ordinance 48-17. An emergency ordinance establishing benefit and compensation plans for identified employees for calendar years 2018, 2019, and 2020. Emergency ordinance 49-17. An emergency ordinance to establish the salaries and compensation of the Dover City Treasurer Dover Council President and the Dover At-large Councilpersons for the terms commencing on January 1, 2018. Emergency ordinance 51-17. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with the Tuscarawas County Board of County Commissioners for housing inmates in the Tuscarawas County jail. Emergency ordinance 52-17. An emergency ordinance making supplemental appropriations and authorizing the transfer of funds to meet current obligations of the City of Dover and the departments therein.
