

The following summary of legislation passed by Dover City Council at its regular meeting the 16<sup>th</sup> day of November 2015 is published once to comply with the Ohio Revised Code. A full copy of the text can be obtained or viewed at the Office of the Mayor of the City of Dover.

Resolution 21-15. A resolution recognizing, commending and thanking James R. Jones for his years of dedicated public service as a Firefighter/EMT from February 24, 1992 through September 30, 2015.

Resolution 22-15. A resolution recognizing, commending and thanking William Hildebrand for his years of dedicated public service in the Wastewater and Service Departments from July 6, 1992 through September 30, 2015.

Emergency resolution 24-15. A resolution authorizing Dover Mayor Richard P. Homrighausen as delegate to represent the City of Dover, Ohio as a member of the Board of Directors of the Ohio Municipal Electric Association.

Emergency ordinance 40-15. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Safety to enter into a contract with the Joint County Public Defender's Office to provide legal counsel to indigent persons charged with loss of liberty offenses in the New Philadelphia Municipal Court, and arising in the City of Dover, at a cost not to exceed \$17,787.00 per year.

Emergency ordinance 44-15. An emergency ordinance to approve the tentative agreement between AFSCME and AFSCME Local 2550 and the City of Dover as negotiated between Dover's representatives and its employees.
