

The following summary of legislation passed by Dover City Council at its regular meeting the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of November 2015 is published once to comply with the Ohio Revised Code. A full copy of the text can be obtained or viewed at the Office of the Mayor of the City of Dover.

Emergency ordinance 37-15. Emergency ordinance to rezone PPN 15-06111-000 134 S. Crater Avenue Dover Ohio to S-1.

Emergency ordinance 39-15. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Dover Service Director to sell by advertisement and receipt of sealed bids, or by internet auction, or by sale through approved governmental auction sites, surplus equipment or vehicles no longer needed by the City of Dover. In the event that attempts at sale are unsuccessful or do not acquire as significant funds as is likely through a sale by scrap, the vehicles and equipment may be sold as scrap. The vehicles and equipment are on file with the Service Director.

Ordinance 42-15. An ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$2,290,000 for the purpose of paying costs of improving the Municipal Electric System by acquiring, constructing, installing and equipping pollution control facilities, all together with all necessary appurtenances thereto, and declaring an emergency.

Emergency ordinance 43-15. An emergency ordinance authorizing Mason Equity Group to remove soil pursuant to DCO 1323.01, 1323.02 and 1323.03.
